

**PtHA of NYS  
RULES FOR 2009 OPEN PINTO FUTURITY**

1. The PtHA of NYS Pinto Futurity **WILL NOT** be Nationally pointed, but will run in accordance with most of the PtHA of America futurity rules.
2. All entries must be registered with the PtHA of America or MUST have conditional registration papers issued by a sector director by the date of the futurity. The Owner of the nominated Pinto must be a member in good standing of the PtHA of America on the date of the futurity, or all winnings will be forfeited. NO PINTO MAY SHOW ON REGISTRATION PENDING.
3. If the nominated Pinto is sold after nomination, the new owner must notify the Futurity Committee within 30 days of the transfer. The new owner must also be a member in good standing of the PtHA of America
4. All horses, ponies and miniatures must meet all PtHA registration requirements.
5. Registration papers will be checked by a Futurity official before classes begin if they have not been sent in with the nomination.
6. All futurity payments stay with the entry to appropriate class. For instance, if a nominated stallion is gelded, he is moved into the proper class and entry money moves with him. The same would be true if a type change is made.
7. Combining or Canceling classes will be done at the discretion of the Futurity Committee. Any classes with less than 2 entries will be combined with the same age group, of opposite sex. (i.e.) Weanling Colts & Geldings with Weanling Fillies.
8. Prize money, ribbons, and/or trophies will be distributed to exhibited Pintos only. Nominees must show in front of all designated judges. Failure to do so will result in disqualification. There will be a minimum of three judges.
9. All monies forfeited will go into the total money paid to the horses in that nomination class. If there are Pintos nominated and none show in the class, the entry money will be added to next year's futurity money.
10. The owners of stillborn foals will be refunded any monies previously paid. NO other refunds will be made. Requests for a refund must be in writing and accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate indicating the reason the refund should be granted.
11. Money on hand will be kept in the PtHA of NYS bank account. The club treasurer and the Futurity Chairperson will keep separate records.
12. The show date will be determined by the Horse Show Committee and advertised by the Futurity Committee with the cooperation of the Publicity Committee.
13. A one-time nominating fee of \$50.00 for each entry/each class is payable by September 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year, or a \$75.00 late nominating Fee payable between September 2<sup>nd</sup> and day before the class. NO EXCEPTIONS.
14. 10% of the nominating fees will go toward the purchase of the current year's ribbons and prizes. This will also cover the highest placing New York bred nominee in each class.

16. All added money, unless specified for a certain class by the contributor, will be added into a class chosen by the Futurity Committee.
17. **All futurity winnings will be mailed within two (2) weeks of the futurity.** For late entries or entries taken at the show- **When the futurity entry check clears the bank.**
18. Following the Futurity Show, all results and monies won will be published in the PtHA of NYS Newsletter.
19. New York Bred is a foal whose dam was owned by a New York resident at the time the mare was bred and the dam resided within NYS at the time of foaling.
20. If two (2) weanlings share a stall, the price of the stall will be \$50.00
22. The NON PRO Pleasure Class is open to all Youth, Novice Amateur/Amateur Owners, per PtHA of America rules.
23. THE STALLION SERVICE CLASS is open to any foal from a donated stallion whether or not purchased thru the PtHA of NYS Stallion Service Auction.

The donated stallions for the 2007 Service Auction were: **A Classical Skip, Bids Night Cap, Bug Zappers Design, Deluxe Dun Awesome, Double Hitter, Justa Pleasure, Kalem's Corona Gold, Lilsonofadun, Our Last Encore, Paycos Pete, Pistol Packin Frekles, Red A Lert, RS Steel Magnolia, Semi Automatic Trigger, Subras Starbuck, Sunday Peanut Brittle, The Quintessential, The CEO, WR Well Versed, Youdonknowjackzip.** ANY 2008 foal (Yearling) sired by any of these stallions is eligible for entry in the 2008 SSA class.

The 2008 Service Auction were: **Bonanza Dot Com, Dominantly Bold, Double Hitter, Justa Pleasure, LTD's Quick Cash, Mighty Awesome Too, Paycos Pete, Pistol Packin Frekles, RR So Far Just Dandy, Semi Automatic Tigger, Sonny's Amigo Bar, Youdontknowjackzip.** ANY 2009 (weanling) foal sired by any of these stallions is eligible for entry in the 2009 SSA class.
